Check out some of Brevard's best burgers

Take a bite out of these classic beef sandwiches

In May, we asked readers to share with us their favorite places in Brevard to grab a big, juicy burger. We ("we" as in this reporter, reporter Chris Kridler and occasionally this reporter's meat-loving husband) took their advice, sampling burgers at 10 independently owned restaurants. If readers suggested a specific burger on the restaurant's menu, we tried that. If they weren't specific, we tried two different burgers on the menu, if offered.

Burgers were rated on taste, size, appearance, creativity and overall experience (including the restaurant's atmosphere and friendliness of the staff) On the rating scale, 5 is the best and 1 is not so good. For the places where we tried more than one burger, we averaged the two scores.

Here are the results:

Harbor City Diner

1630 S. Wickham Road, West Melbourne, 952-0707

Burger names: Harbor City Burger and the Buffalo Burger

Taste: 5

Size: 5

Appearance: 3

Creativity: 3.5

Experience: 3

Notes: There are 13 burgers on the menu ranging from \$4.99 to \$6.99, and it's \$1.99 extra if you want fries, lettuce, tomatoes, pickles and slaw. Harbor City is the restaurant we got the most suggestions for, and now we know why. One of the restaurant's massive 12-ounce burgers is big enough to feed a family of four, and it's tasty, too. It may not be the fanciest dining room in the land, but Harbor City Diner has the right to claim it has "the best burgers in town."
